SEATTLE SONICS SIGN SECOND-ROUND PICK DAVID YOUNG

ATLANTA, GA. - Former North Carolina Central University standout and All-CIAA player David Young officially joined the Seattle Sonics roster signing a multi-year contract with the club.

Young was chosen with the 41st overall pick in the second-round during this summer's NBA Draft. He comes to the Pacific Northwest having averaged 20.5 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.4 assists while leading the Eagles to the CIAA Tournament Championship game. Young also played for the WBA Raleigh Knights.

Young also participated in the Sonics' summer league team averaging 5.0 points per game and leading the squad in three-point field goals.

This past April he was among the many athletes competing in the WBA Black College All-Star Game which was played in Atlanta at Morehouse College.

The WBA season runs April, May and June with franchises in Rome, GA; Jackson, MS; Macon, GA; Peachtree City, GA; Bristol, TN; Elizabeth Town, KY and Raleigh, NC.
